




Connecting Devices to other networks

Chromebooks:

When you first fire it up, in the lower right corner, there is a spot with a battery icon and clock icon. Click here and it will show you available networks  that you can join. Select yours, enter password if it is secured. Now that you are connected to the network click on “sign in with a different account” where it says Sign in to your Chromebook. Enter your school email and password and you should be good to go. Students must be signed in to use google classroom and/or Zoom. If you have multiple students using the device, make sure they sign out of their account, again in the bottom right before the next child needs to use it.

MacBooks

In the username and password, where it says name enter the word student and the next box where it says password enter the word swanville. Both are lowercase. Go up to the top right hand corner and look for the wireless signal icon , look for your home wireless connection, if you see this  by the name of the network, you will need a password to join. Select your network.

If you don't have internet at home, you can sit outside of the school in your car and join our guest wireless. Many other businesses also have free wifi connections, the laundromat in town has one, the network is just called Tony, no password needed to join. As is the caution now though, keep your 6 foot distance between you and others.
